

2 What do libraries in the new era look like?



3 Objectives of Formulation

What is expected of libraries in the future is to fulfill their mission as "Local Knowledge Base", to strengthen the network that transcends the boundaries of residents, communities, businesses, and government in order to support "new learning in the new era", and to open the door to the future of the community by "creating connections" through encounters between books and people and between people through books.

"The Saitama City Library Vision (Phase 2)" will be formulated with the aim of sharing this evolving and developing mission of the library with residents and librarians.

1 Basic Principles

The library provides optimal information where anyone can freely obtain the knowledge and all kinds of information to live. We support "new learning in the new era" by helping users acquire information literacy to effectively select and use information.

At the same time, the library will take further steps to become "'a knowledge site' where books and people meet", and a center of information literacy where people can gather, connect, create knowledge, and participate in society.

Basic Principles : "A knowledge site" where people and books meet


"The knowledge site" is "a new image of the library" created by residents and a network of 25 libraries within the city.

"The knowledge site" is not just a place for people to gather and use the library's resources. It is a place where people bring and share their knowledge, and engage in activities. It is also a place where people with diverse backgrounds and people of different generations can meet and interact with each other, and therefore expanding the circle of connections between books and people, and between people.

These "connections" create new value and innovation by solving problems in individual lives and in local communities, and foster local culture. And therefore, creating a bright future for "each individual person" and "the city".

2 Basic Directions

In order to realize the Saitama City Library's basic philosophy, "'a knowledge site' where books and people meet", four basic directions have been established.



*Information literacy … The ability to use information well. The knowledge and skills to collect, analyze, and utilize necessary information from a large amount of information.
